Our lawful bases for collecting or using personal information is to collaborate with partner organizations to develop and enhance tools and methodologies for documenting, analyzing, and reporting on co-creation workshops and group dialogue processes are:

 Consent - we have permission from you after we gave you all the relevant information. All of your data protection rights may apply, except the right to object. To be clear, you do have the right to withdraw your consent at any time.

### How long we keep information

## We retain personal information according to the following schedule:

 Audio Recordings: Audio recordings of our co-creative workshops will be permanently deleted immediately after they have been successfully transcribed by deliberAIde using Azure AI Speech Services.

- Transcripts: Transcripts of the audio recordings will be temporarily stored until they have been successfully de-identified and anonymised using Azure AI Speech Services. After de-identification, the original transcripts will be permanently deleted.
- De-identified/Anonymised Transcripts: Only the de-identified and anonymised transcripts will be retained by deliberAIde. These will be kept for the purpose of developing and enhancing tools and methodologies for documenting, analysing, and reporting on cocreation workshops and group dialogue processes.

### Who we share information with

Data processors

These data processors do the following activities for us:

- 1. Lukas Salecker & Co GbR deliberAIde (civic technologies), Siegen, Germany Lukas Salecker & Co GbR assists us by transcribing audio recordings of our co-creative workshops. They de-identify the transcripts to remove any personal identifiers, ensuring participant anonymity. The de-identified transcripts are then stored and aggregated. They use these aggregated transcripts to analyze the effectiveness of their tools and services, to improve and add features to their offerings, to conduct research, and for other similar purposes that contribute to the enhancement of their technologies.
- 2. Azure AI Speech Service (cloud services), Germany West Central region, Frankfurt, Germany Azure AI Speech Service provides us with cloud-based transcription services for our audio recordings. They transcribe the audio content and de-identify the transcripts by removing personal identifiers. This service helps us obtain accurate textual representations of our workshops while maintaining the privacy and confidentiality of the participants.

We have a joint controller relationship with Lukas Salecker & Co GbR - deliberAIde . We process your personal information with that joint controller for the following reason: We are collaborating with the joint controller, deliberAIde, because they are our partner organisation specialising in the development of AI tools and AI-driven methodologies for documenting, analysing, and reporting on co-creation workshops and group dialogue processes. deliberAIde is an Oxford University Innovation startup that we aim to support by providing test data for their tool development. Advanced Oxford and deliberAIde jointly collect personal information during our co-creative workshop(s). We work together to decide how this data will be used to achieve our shared purpose: to develop and enhance tools and methodologies for co-creation processes. This involves recording workshops, analysing participant interactions, and using these insights to refine AI-driven documentation and reporting tools.
